Why MarketCap.com sits in its own tier. The crypto-only version of this term, CoinMarketCap.com, grew into a top-600 website globally and sold to Binance for a reported \$400 million. MarketCap.com is the generic parent term covering every asset class - stocks, crypto, commodities, funds, real estate and beyond. Serious offers start in the seven figures; a strategic buyer should expect eight.

Why Eurosummer.com is priced as a brand, not a keyword. With hundreds of thousands of TikTok posts, billions of views across the European-summer tag family, its own fashion aesthetic and songs, and a media cycle that repeats every year, "Euro summer" behaves like an established consumer brand that nobody owns yet. The exact .com is the way to own it.

Domain profiles

1. MarketCap.com

Own the metric. Every asset on earth has one.

Minimum \$1,500,000 | Medium \$4,000,000 | Top match \$10,000,000+

"Market cap" is the single most universal number in finance. It is quoted for every listed stock, every cryptocurrency, every commodity producer, every ETF and, increasingly, every private company and tokenised asset. Nobody has to explain what MarketCap.com means, in any language.

The proof of concept already exists: CoinMarketCap.com, built on the crypto slice of this term alone, became one of the most visited financial sites in the world and was acquired by Binance in 2020 for a reported \$400 million, largely for its traffic. CompaniesMarketCap.com, StockAnalysis and similar sites have repeated the pattern for equities. MarketCap.com is the parent term above all of them: stocks, crypto, commodities, real estate, funds, sports franchises, art, collectibles - all types of assets, one unified ranking.

Natural owners: a global exchange (Binance, Coinbase, Kraken, Crypto.com, Nasdaq, ICE, LSEG), a market-data giant (Bloomberg, Refinitiv, S&P Global, MSCI, Morningstar), a broker or super-app (Robinhood, eToro, Revolut, Trade Republic), or a media brand (Yahoo Finance, Investing.com). Comparable ultra-premium sales include Voice.com (\$30M), Crypto.com (reported \$12M), Rocket.com (\$14M) and Chat.com.

Top match: a well-funded exchange, data provider or fintech that wants to own the term and build the "CoinMarketCap for everything".

2. Eurosummer.com

A season that became a brand.

Minimum \$150,000 | Medium \$400,000 | Top match \$1,000,000+

"Euro summer" is no longer a description, it is a cultural franchise. On TikTok alone the #eurosummer hashtag carries roughly 650,000 posts, with the wider European-summer tag family running into billions of views; Instagram, YouTube and Pinterest add millions more. It has spawned its own fashion aesthetic (linen, Aperol, Riviera stripes), packing lists, playlists, songs, memes and an annual media cycle from May to September that returns every year.

The domain is the exact one-word .com for that entire movement. It works as a travel booking brand, tour operator, curated-trips club, apparel and swimwear label, festival, media/creator network, or a seasonal campaign hub for an airline, hotel group or drinks brand.

Comparable travel and lifestyle brandables in the six and seven figures include Summer.com, Vacation.com, Cruise.com and Beach.com. Very few trend-defining terms are still available as a clean .com.

Top match: an OTA (Booking, Expedia, GetYourGuide), a lifestyle/apparel group, a beverage brand running an annual summer campaign, or a media company building a creator-led travel brand.

3. SkyPhone.com

The phone that works everywhere - including above the clouds.

Minimum \$60,000 | Medium \$150,000 | Top match \$500,000+

Two dictionary words, instantly understood, and perfectly timed. Direct-to-cell satellite service (Starlink, AST SpaceMobile, Apple, T-Mobile) is turning the sky into a network, and "sky phone" is the plain-English name for what consumers will call it. It equally suits an in-flight connectivity brand, an eSIM/roaming service, a VoIP or cloud-phone product, or a next-generation handset.

Top match: a satellite/direct-to-cell operator, airline connectivity provider or global eSIM brand.

4. BankCredit.com

Two of the most valuable words in finance, side by side.

Minimum \$60,000 | Medium \$180,000 | Top match \$500,000+

An exact-match, high-intent finance name. "Bank" and "credit" are among the most expensive keywords in paid search, and together they describe the core product of every lender, neobank, credit-card issuer and comparison site. Highly credible as a consumer brand, and equally strong for a B2B credit or trade-finance platform.

Top match: a bank or credit provider launching a digital brand, a credit marketplace, or a BNPL/lending fintech.

5. BioSynt.com

Where biology meets synthesis - in the lab or in the machine.

Minimum \$15,000 | Medium \$40,000 | Top match \$150,000+

A short, pronounceable, company-grade name at the intersection of two booming fields. In life sciences it reads as biosynthesis, synthetic biology, biomanufacturing or biosimilars. In AI it reads as "synthesised biology": humanoid robotics, digital humans, AI agents that model human behaviour, bio-inspired computing and neuro-symbolic systems. One name, two of the decade's biggest venture themes.

Top match: a synthetic-biology startup, a humanoid/AI-robotics company or a digital-human platform.

6. PABX.com

A telecom icon - and four letters that can mean whatever you build.

Minimum \$25,000 | Medium \$60,000 | Top match \$200,000+

PABX (Private Automatic Branch Exchange) is the classic term for the business phone system, still used worldwide by telecom operators, UCaaS vendors and VoIP resellers. As a four-letter, exact-match .com with real meaning it carries a solid floor value.

But the letters also invite play: P for Private, Public or Personal; A for Automatic, AI, Autonomous or Agent; B for Branch, Block, Bank or Bot; X for eXchange, eXternal or eXperience. "Public AI Block eXchange", "Personal Agent Bot eXchange", "Private Asset Block eXchange" - a crypto exchange, AI-agent marketplace or fintech can wear PABX as a modern brand while inheriting decades of recognition.

Top match: a UCaaS/VoIP vendor, or a fintech/AI startup that wants a short, punchy four-letter brand.

7. Iptele.com

IP + tele: short enough for a logo, clear enough for a category.

Minimum \$4,000 | Medium \$10,000 | Top match \$35,000+

Six letters combining IP and tele for VoIP, IPTV, telemedicine (tele-health over IP) or telecom infrastructure. Easy to spell and pronounce across languages, which makes it well suited to international carriers and streaming providers.

Top match: an international VoIP/IPTV operator or a telehealth platform seeking a short brand.

8. IpTelephony.com

The category, spelled out.

Minimum \$6,000 | Medium \$18,000 | Top match \$60,000+

An exact-match industry term for voice over IP as a whole. Ideal for a VoIP provider, B2B communications company, hosted-PBX vendor or an authoritative information and comparison portal. Descriptive names of this type deliver instant credibility and search relevance.

Top match: a VoIP provider or UCaaS vendor wanting the category term for authority and search.

9. SipServer.com

The protocol behind every modern phone call.

Minimum \$5,000 | Medium \$12,000 | Top match \$40,000+

SIP (Session Initiation Protocol) is the backbone of VoIP and unified communications, and the SIP server is the product every vendor sells. Precise, technical and trusted; attractive for open-source projects, hosted-PBX providers and telecom infrastructure companies.

Top match: a SIP software or hosted-PBX vendor.

10. CapValue.com

Capital, valuation, value - the sibling of MarketCap.com.

Minimum \$6,000 | Medium \$18,000 | Top match \$60,000+

A clean two-word finance name suggesting capital, valuation and market value. Fits an investment firm, valuation service, cap-table/equity-management tool or a financial advisory brand. Can be sold together with MarketCap.com as a matched pair for a data or valuation platform.

Top match: an investment or valuation firm; ideal as a bundle with MarketCap.com.

11. Crosat.com

Cross + sat: a small name for a big orbit.

Minimum \$3,000 | Medium \$7,000 | Top match \$25,000+

A short, pronounceable six-letter brandable with a technical edge, evoking cross-satellite links, cross-border logistics or cross-platform software. Suits a space/comms startup, a logistics or tracking brand, or a SaaS product that wants a name it can own outright.

Top match: a satellite, IoT or logistics startup that wants this specific name.

Bundles and terms

Suggested bundles: **MarketCap.com + CapValue.com** (finance data pair); **PABX.com + IpTelephony.com + SipServer.com + Iptele.com** (complete telecom/VoIP set); **SkyPhone.com + Iptele.com** (consumer telecom). All domains are owned outright and transferred via Escrow.com or a broker of the buyer's choice. Valuations are the seller's estimates

based on comparable sales, traffic data and market trends, and are not formal appraisals.
